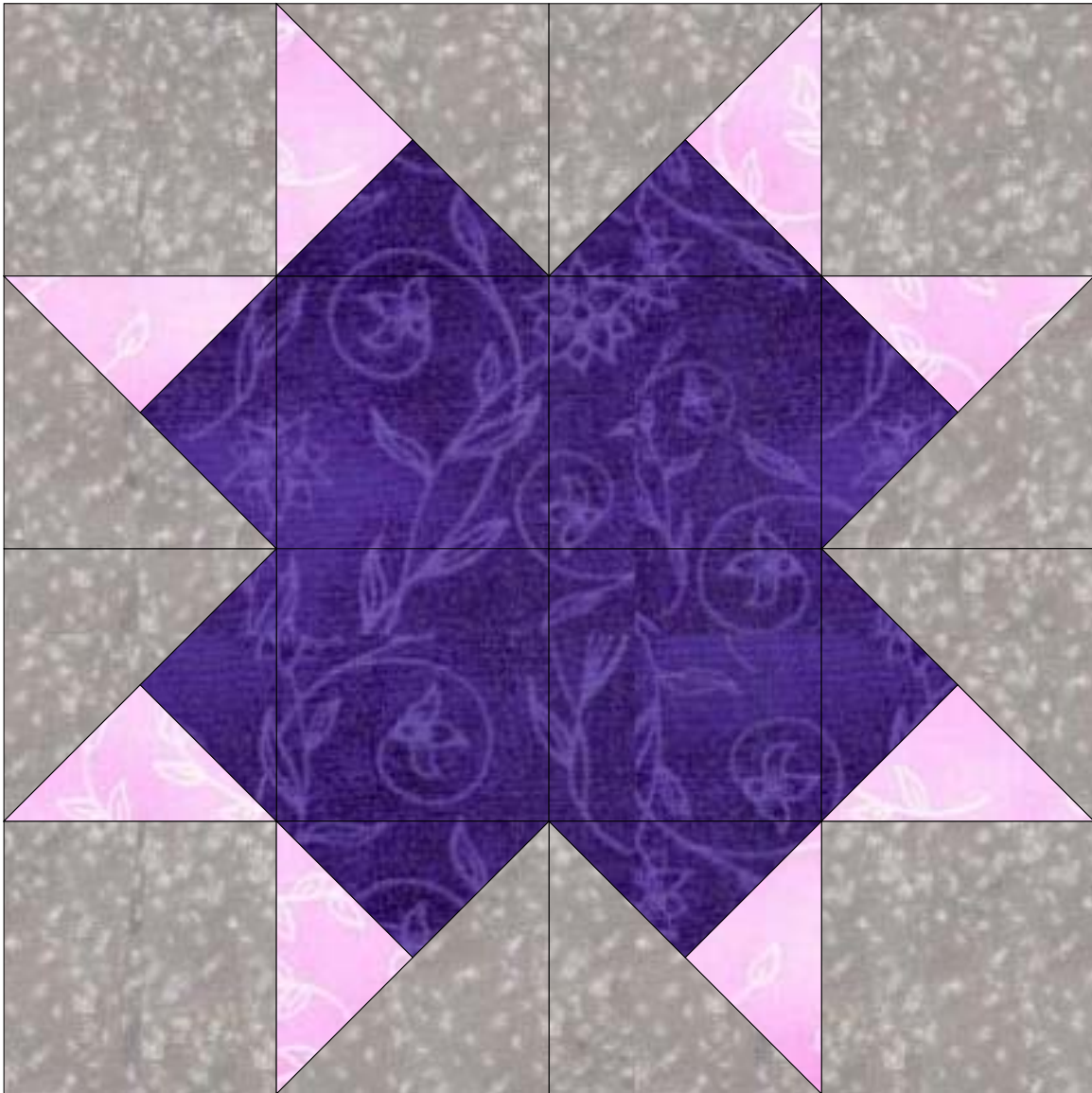


Aunt Addie's Album - 8 inch block

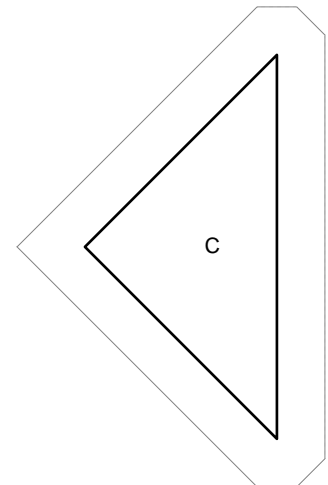

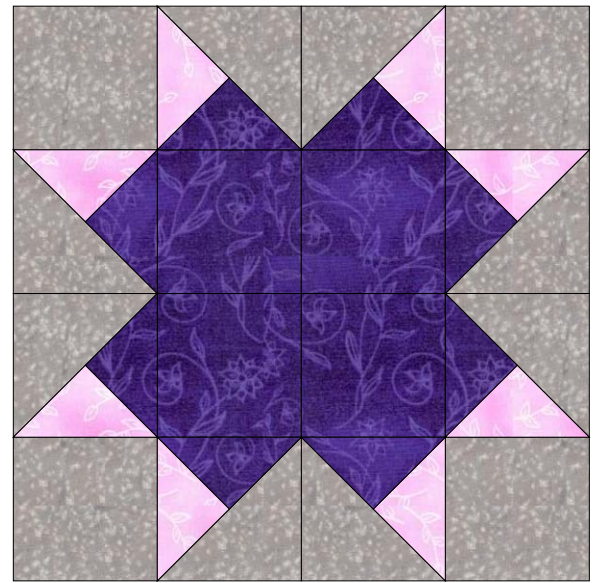
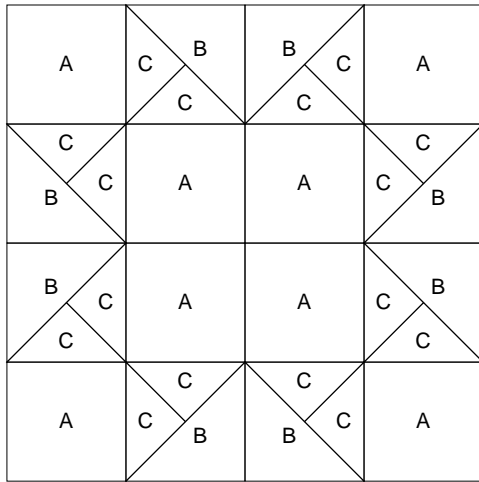
